Rosmellyn Surgery Boundary Area: LN discussed catchment areas with the PPG and how Rosmellyn wish to challenge our hard and soft borders. Rosmellyn will lose patients who have been registered with us for a long time over a staggered process rather than in one go. KT emphasised patients will not be refused to be seen.
